The mission of SafeHaven is to end domestic violence through **safety, support, prevention and social change.**

## SAFETY

SafeHaven of Tarrant County provides a 24-hour hotline answered by trained bilingual advocates that facilitate crisis intervention, safety assessment, information and referrals, access to emergency shelters, and connection to SafeHaven's services.

Additionally, SafeShelter in Arlington and Fort Worth provide emergency shelter totaling a 164 bed capacity.

## SUPPORT

SafeHaven of Tarrant County provides *clinical services, transitional and permanent housing, and legal assistance* to help support survivors in need.

Support services are provided at the shelters, two resource centers in Arlington and Fort Worth and scattered site for housing services.

## PREVENTION

SafeHaven of Tarrant County provides school-based prevention services using evidence-based antiviolence curriculum. Domestic violence information and prevention provided to schools, students and the community-at-large with the goal of preventing future violence.


## SOCIAL CHANGE

SafeHaven of Tarrant County provides psycho-educational services to perpetrators through the state-approved Battering Intervention and Prevention Program (BIPP) that delivers education about the fundamentals of leading a nonviolence lifestyle. The goal of BIPP is to achieve the social change necessary to eliminate domestic violence.




